TO PHEPARE FOR THE PROJECT: Clear a work space and do an inventory of all the pieces in this kit. Carefully measure each piece. With a pencil, lightly label each piece with the capitalized letter that corresponds with the list below.

#### SMALL ACCORDION:

- two pieces--4 '/4" x 4 '/4" (outside bookboard covers)
- one piece--4" x 40" (ten section accordion)
- two pieces--5 '/4" x 5 '/4" (decorative paper cover material)


#### MEDIUM ACCORDION:

- two pieces--5 '/8" x 7 '/8" (outside bookboard covers)
- one piece--7" x 40" (eight section accordion)
- two pieces--6 '/8" x 8 '/8" (decorative paper cover material)

#### LARGE ACCORDION:

- $\checkmark$  two pieces--4  $^{1}I_{4}$ " x 8  $^{1}I_{2}$ " (outside bookboard covers)
- one piece--8 '/4" x 40" (ten section accordion)
- two pieces--5 '/4" x 9 '/2" (decorative paper cover material)

#### PIBBON: three pieces--45" each










MAHING THE MEDIUM ACCORDION: Use pieces D, E and F.

- place a sheet of decorative paper, piece , with the pattern side down.
- **✔Glue Tips** and apply glue to the entire backside of the sheet of decorative paper.
- center and glue a piece of bookboard, piece  $\mathcal{D}$ , to the decorative paper, **figure 1**.
- ✓ Glue Tips, clip corners and wrap edges, figure 2.
- repeat the above steps with the remaining D and F pieces.










ATTACHING THE BIBBON: Use a piece D covered with a piece F and the ribbon.

- place a cover piece with the exposed bookboard facing up.
- using a pencil and a ruler, on the short dimension of the cover, lightly draw a line along the center, **figure 3**.
- apply glue along the center line but do not apply glue all the way to the edges. Leave about an  $^{1}/_{8}$ " glue-free margin on both edges, figure 4.
- fold the ribbon in half and crease at the fold to mark the center point of the ribbon.
- position the crease mark roughly in the center of the cover and glue the ribbon down over the pencil line, figure 5.





ATTACHING THE COVER TO THE ACCORDION: Use all of the pieces.

- fold up the pages, piece , along the embossed marks to make an accordion, figure 6. Use the point of the bone folder to burnish the folds so that the accordion lies flat.
- place one of the covers, a piece overed by a piece , bookboard side face-up.
- insert a piece of scrap paper under the first page of the accordion, **figure** 7. This protects the pages from glue.
- making sure to cover the entire surface, apply glue to the outside of the first page, figure 8.
- remove the scrap paper.
- center and glue the accordion onto the bookboard side of one of the covers. Smooth down the glued surface with a small wad of waxed paper.
- repeat the above steps for the second cover.
